Dear Sirs,

With further referencé to our letter dated April 29th, 1946 please be advised that we are always interested in the fate of the above named childred.

Zew Sperling is in good health and is under the care of Mrs. Pociépna in Częstochowa.

Unfortunately, there is bad news to be reported with regard to Wanda Kozusznik. According to information received the child was shot to death in the street on 22nd April, 1946 not far from its home. The child was playing with its fellows when a woman passing by produced some shots at the children and Wanda Kozusznik was killed on the spot. The child was buried at the Jewish cemetery in Krakow.

Regarding the child Zew Sperling we are writing at the same time to the Coordination Committee for Youth and Children "Ichud" and "Hechaluc Pioneer" with a demand to place the child in a Jewish surroundings with the purpose to transport it, subsequestly, to its relatives in Palestine.
